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Assessment research (Assessment Division)

The research team within the assessment directorate is responsible for ensuring that IB assessment and its examinations processing are appropriately informed by current research. As such, the department:

- Provides and analyses a rich source of meaningful data to effectively support assessment practices and the curriculum review process
- Ensures that assessment is well-grounded in current understanding of best practice
- Underpins potential changes in assessment and marking practice in the light of advances in technology with appropriate research to ensure that the IB does not risk the integrity of its results
- Ensures that the grades awarded to candidates are valid, reliable and fair and that standards remain consistent over time.

Quality Assurance

Professional Development (PD)

- Implemented QAF since 2010
- Multiple data sources (WLS, FR, Observer, Participants)
- Reporting on the past 3 years of data collection, showing high levels of participant satisfaction (i.e. 91% rating as good, very good or excellent) in IB workshops

School Services

- School Authorization process (SA)
- 14 questionnaires developed, started to collect data from schools in early July 2013.





Quality Assurance, Continued

IB Surveys

- All surveys from IB staff or departments that go to external stakeholders
- Implemented in July, 2012

School Satisfaction Survey (SSS)

- Looks at services and supports, image and communication, curriculum and assessment, among other dimensions
- The 6th year in administering SSS allowing for longitudinal analysis



Support and Services

- Increased production of informational material
 - Quick info sheets
 - Literature reviews on IB programmes
 - Regular updates on all current research in the field
- Redeveloped IERD to provide greater functionality and usability to researchers and IB staff
- Presence at leading international research conferences
 - American Educational Research Association (AERA) 2014 annual conference
 - Australian Association for Research in Education (AARE) 2013 annual conference
- Funding awarded to 14 IB teachers in 9 countries for independent research projects
- Ongoing redesign of the Programme Development research web pages
