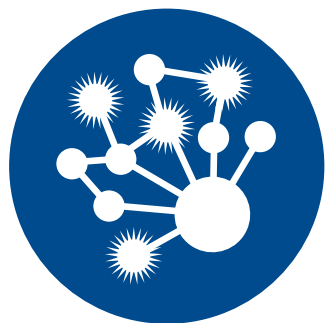

You will delve deeper into curriculum development, pedagogy and assessment through exploring relevant literature and your own IB practices.

IB certificates in leadership

Empowering leaders in international education

Along with the degree that you receive from a recognized university, the IB certificate in leadership practice and the IB advanced certificate in leadership research formally acknowledge an understanding of the principles and practices of leadership associated with becoming an IB World School and implementing the four IB programmes. The IB certificates are achieved through undertaking specific IB-recognized leadership courses. These courses allow you to build and reflect on the leadership capabilities that are involved in authorization and evaluation at an IB World School and implementing and sustaining IB programmes.

Individuals certificated in IB leadership inspire and guide school communities to implement and sustain IB programmes at IB World Schools. IB certificates in leadership acknowledge understanding of the principles and practices associated with leading in an IB World School and wider IB community.

The IB offers two distinct IB certification experiences in leadership development:

- The IB certificate in leadership practice supports educators and administrators who want to improve their leadership capabilities or career aspirations in an IB context. Participants develop and refine their ability to take on leadership responsibilities and understand their role in guiding a school through IB authorization and implementation.
- The IB advanced certificate in leadership research uses rigorous investigative work to give educators and administrators a more profound understanding of IB leadership responsibilities and capabilities. It includes research within the context of IB leadership as well as deep reflection on personal leadership practice.

The IB's highly acclaimed, research-based curriculum will encourage you to think critically and develop open-mindedness and respect for individuals at the world at large.

It recognizes the applied understanding of the role that leadership plays in taking a school through authorization, and addresses issues related to the implementation of one or more IB programmes.

IB advanced certificate in leadership research

The **IB advanced certificate in leadership research** develops students' profound understanding of leadership responsibilities and capabilities through rigorous investigative work in IB leadership contexts and deep reflection on their own leadership practice.

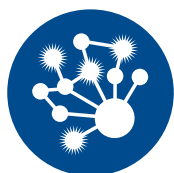

UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES OF PROGRAM

This IB-recognized program of study is designed to develop practical understanding of curriculum, pedagogy and assessment issues related to the implementation of an IB programme.

Learners will develop a sound practical understanding of one IB programme (Primary Years Programme, Middle Years Programme or Diploma Programme) and its implementation, and will understand the continuum of three IB programmes at a basic level.

All faculty teaching in the program have extensive IB experience. The program can be completed as a stand-alone program or credits can be applied toward Bethel University's Master of Arts in Education K–12.

REQUIRED COURSES

For the IB certificate in teaching and learning, the student must take the following courses:

- EDUC771 Curriculum Processes (3 credits)
- EDUC772 Assessment and Learning (3 credits)
- EDUC773 Teaching and Learning (3 credits)
- EDUC774 Capstone (1 credit)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must hold a national teaching qualification/license or have a minimum of three years full-time professional teaching experience in an independent or private government-approved/registered school in the subject or age domain in which they intend to register for the certificate.

UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES OF PROGRAM

This rigorous two-year program in teacher education at the Bilkent University Graduate School of Education awards a Masters degree in Curriculum and Instruction, together with an IB certificate in teaching and learning. In addition, students receive a teacher qualification that enables graduates to teach in high schools.

The Graduate School of Education accepts students on scholarship in five subject areas: biology, physics, mathematics, Turkish language and literature and English. These students are then trained to be high school teachers in Turkey, especially in IB World Schools.

Scholarship includes tuition-fee, accommodation on campus, and internships in Turkey and at the University of Cambridge, and an independent school, in England.

UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES OF PROGRAM

International and local students: Networking and collaboration are embedded in all program coursework as candidates grow in professional teaching skills. Our program participants come from Asia to the Middle East, Canada to Mexico, and of course, the United States. This affordable, two-semester program caters to large group training such as an entire school faculty, or individual participants looking to grow professionally.

Program pacing: We believe that teachers studying the IB philosophy and framework need time to bring practical IB strategies and lessons into the classroom, so the CSUSM IB educator certificate program delivers weekly online lessons for 30 weeks that participants experience at their own pace. Each three-unit class is supported with two units of field experience completed in the participant's school or at a cooperating school in his or her local area.

Program strengths: The program faculty are IB school principals, assistant principals, researchers and programme coordinators. With faculty expertise, the convenience of the a-synchronous online program, and good value, the CSUSM program can meet the needs of all aspiring IB teachers. Candidates who successfully complete one of these courses of study are eligible to apply and earn the IB certificate in teaching and learning.

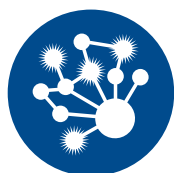

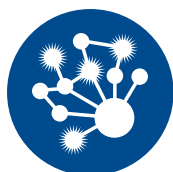

The MA (Hons) Education in primary teaching for children 3-12 combines theory and personal/professional development with practical school experience from year one.

We provide a practicum of six weeks for our first year students in a local primary school.

In semester one of second year, students following the IB Pathway take an IB Policy, Practice and Programmes elective, during which they develop their understanding of the underpinning philosophies of the IB and the main PYP pedagogical approaches. In semester two, students apply this understanding to practice by spending six weeks in an IB PYP school, which is likely to be abroad.

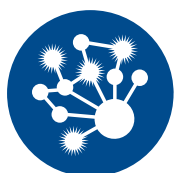
