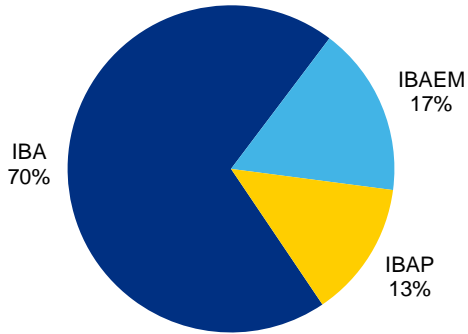

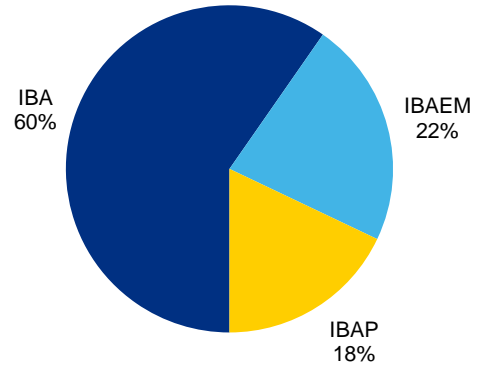

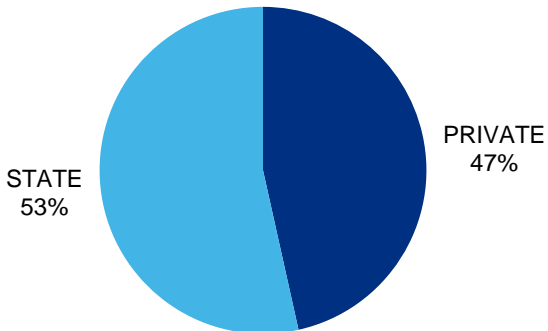
Authorized MYP Schools by Region



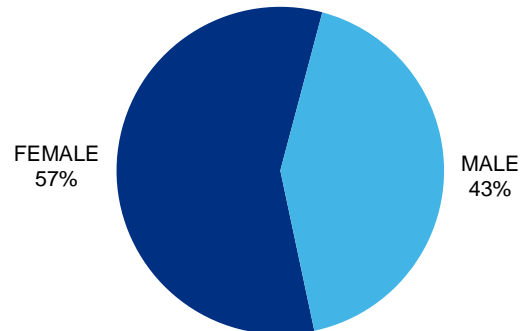
MYP Certificate Candidates by Region



MYP Certificate Candidates by Legal Status

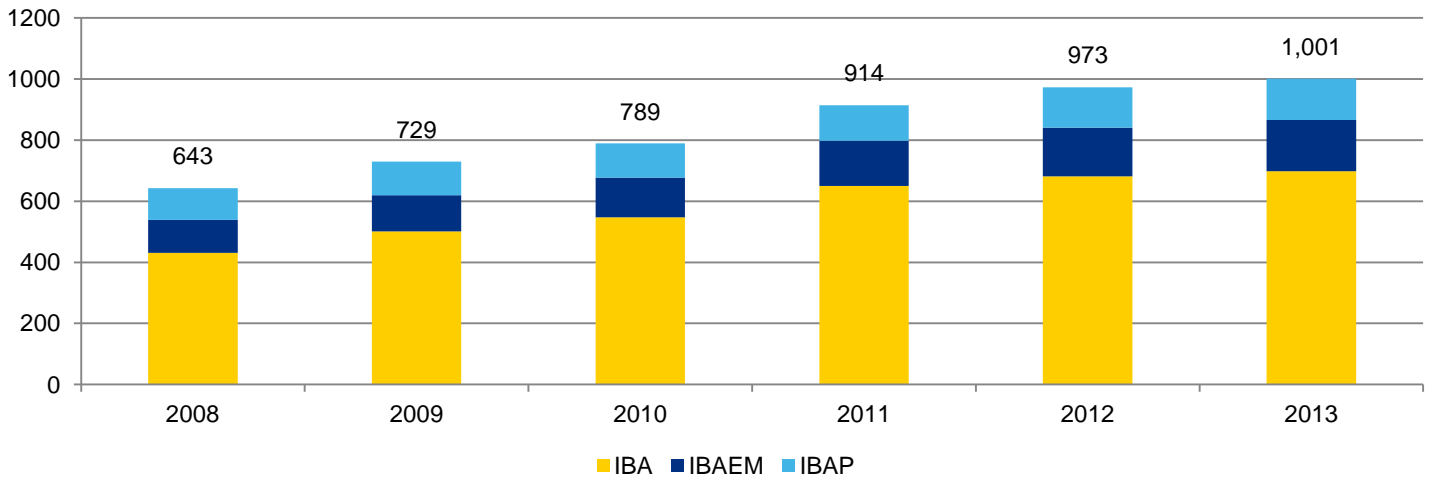


MYP Certificate Candidates by Gender

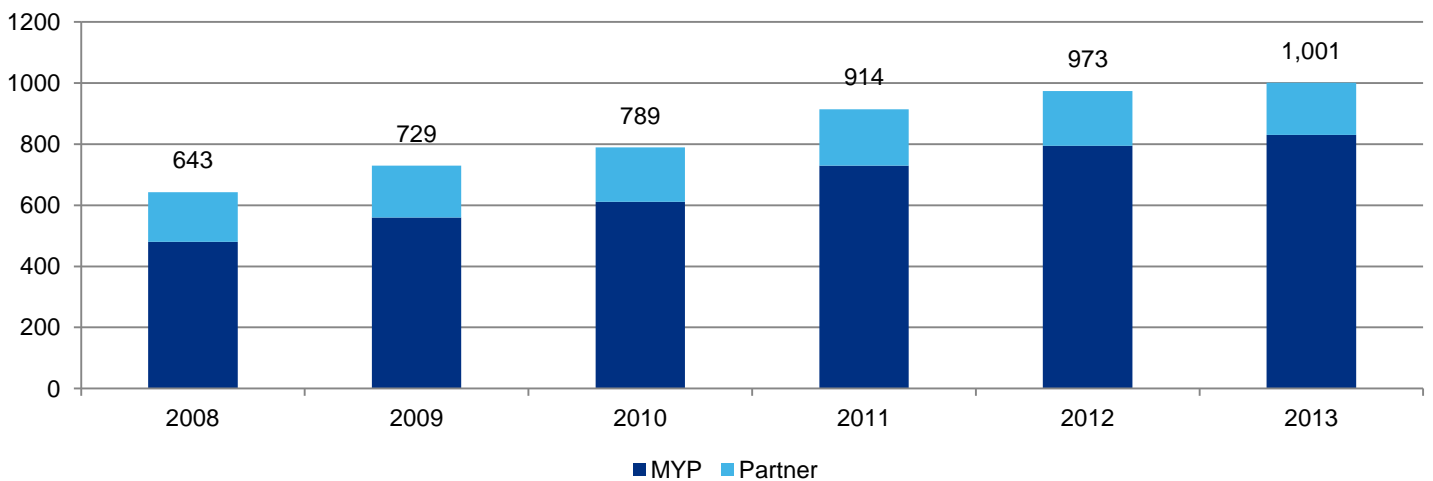

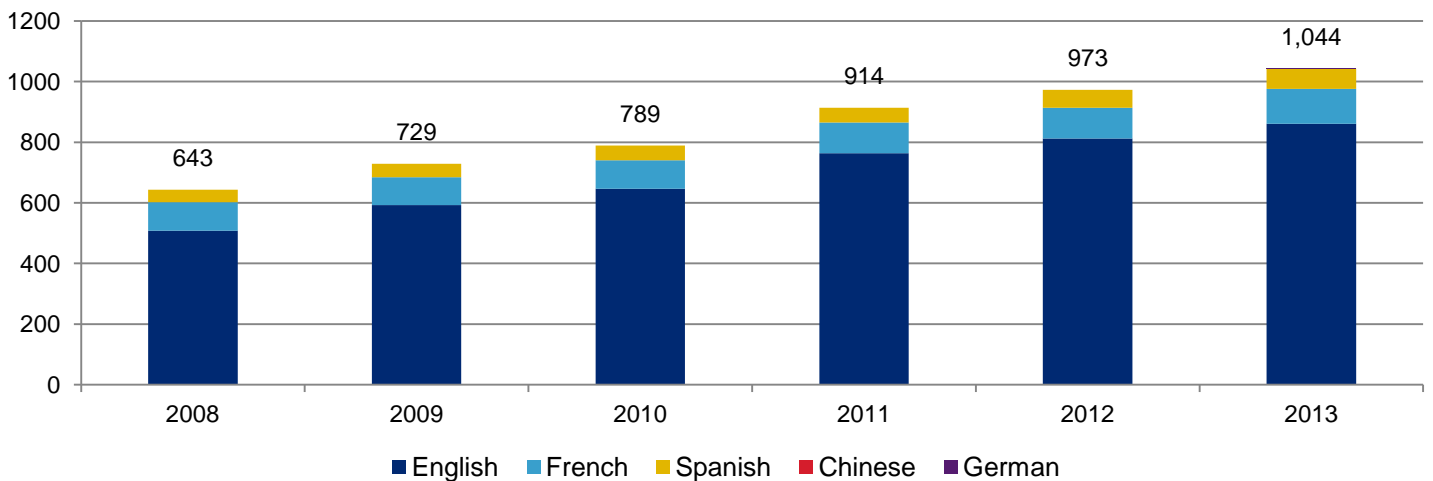
MYP Schools by Region



MYP School Growth by School Type



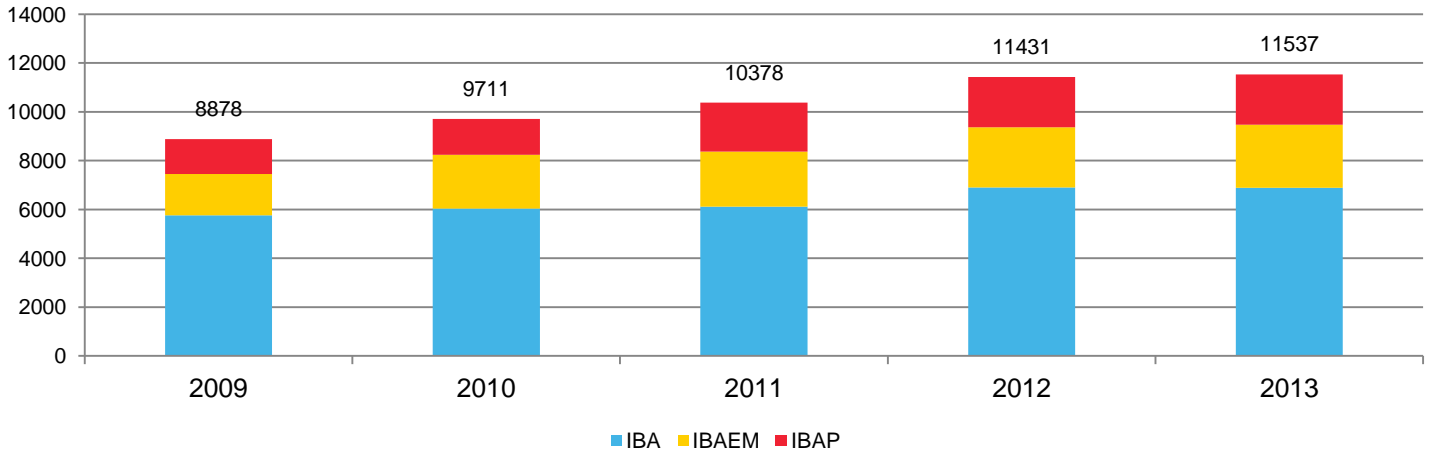

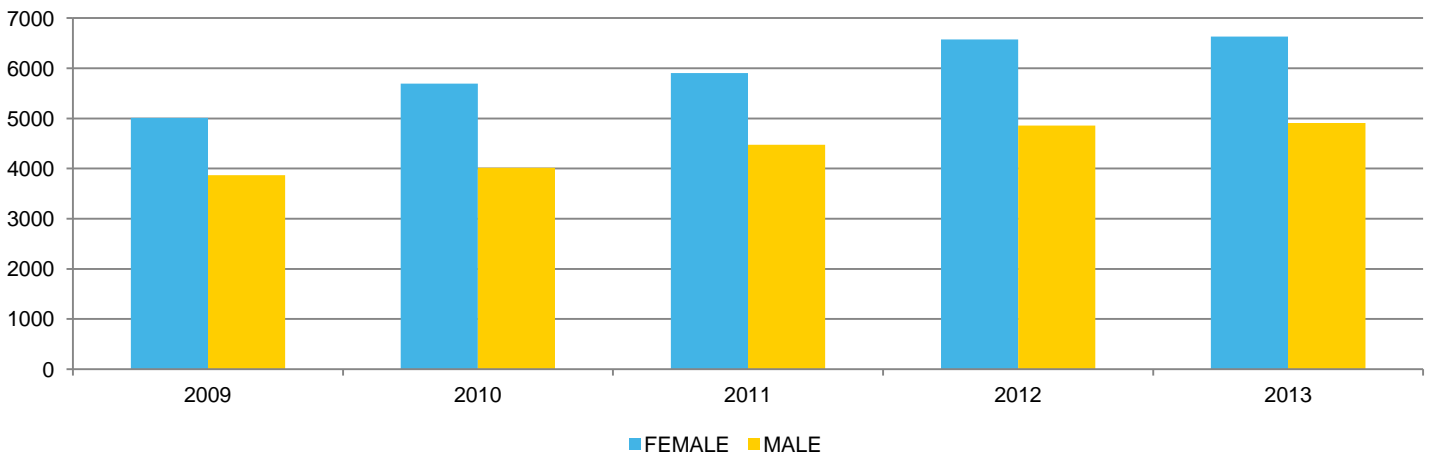

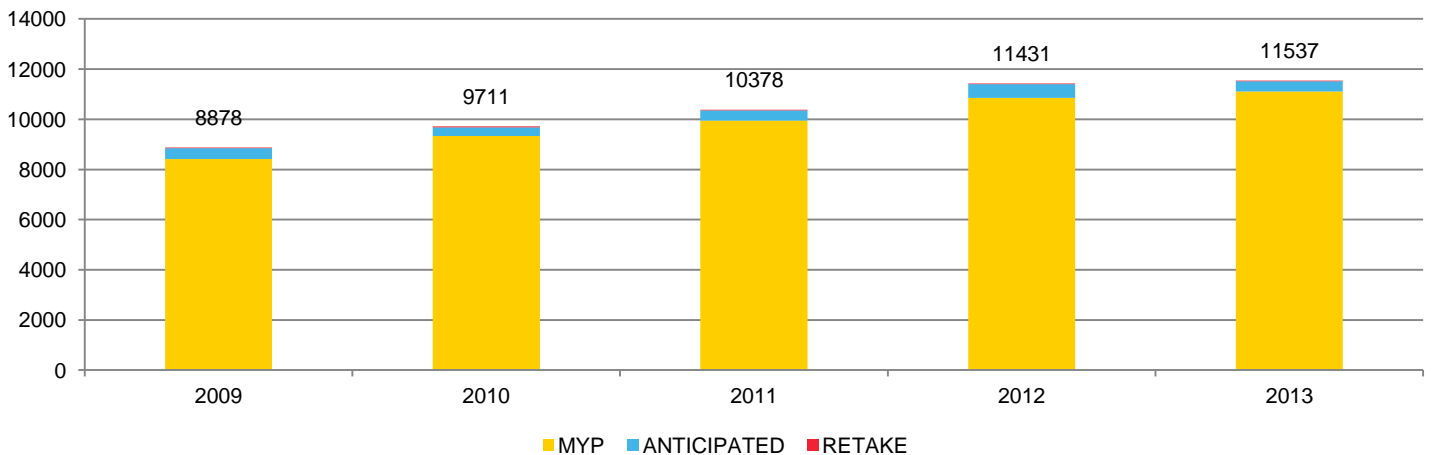
MYP Certificate Candidates by Region



MYP Certificate Candidates by Gender

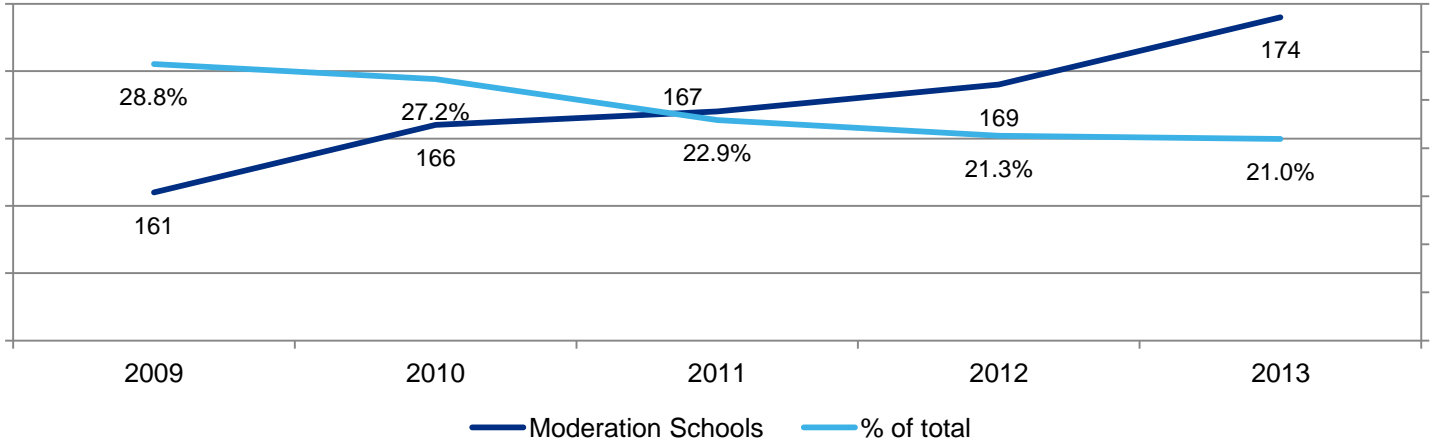


MYP Certificate Candidates by Category

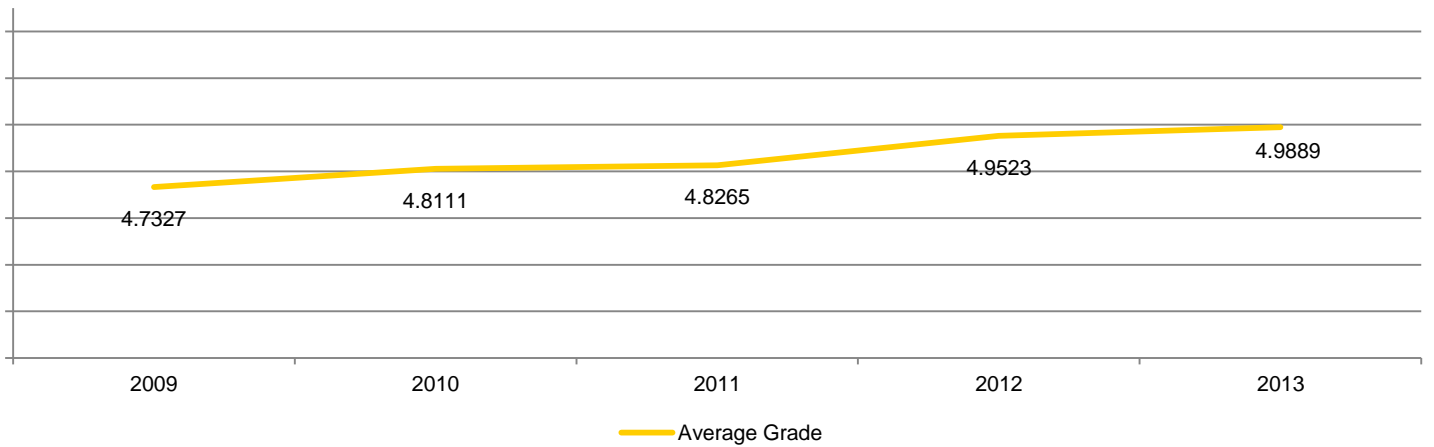

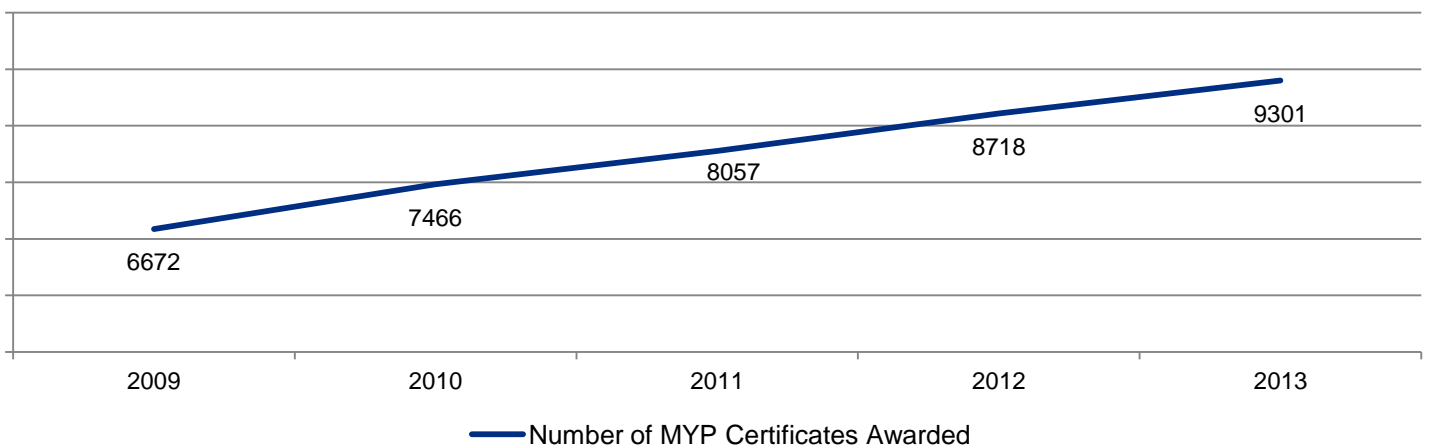
Number and Percent of Schools with Certificate Candidates
