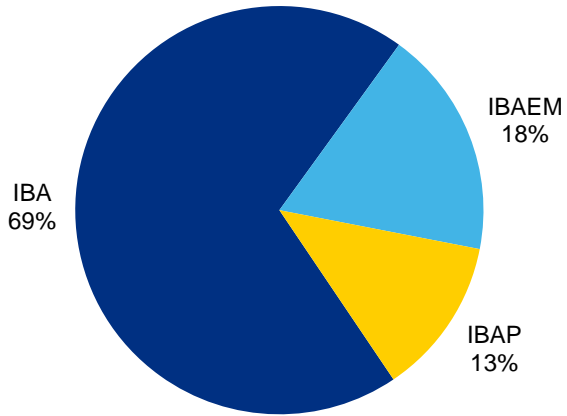

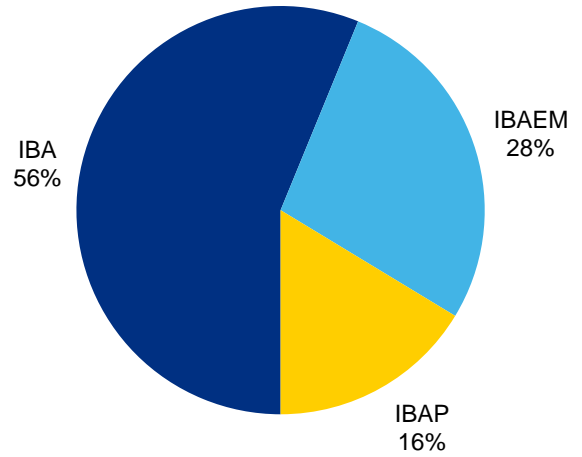

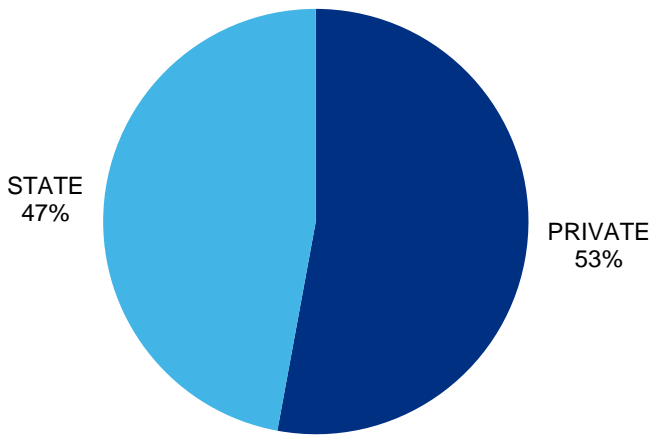
### Authorized MYP Schools by Region



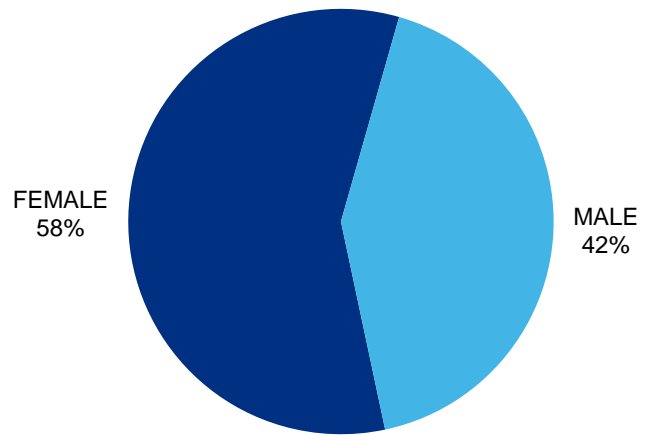
### MYP Candidates by Region



### MYP Candidates by Legal Status

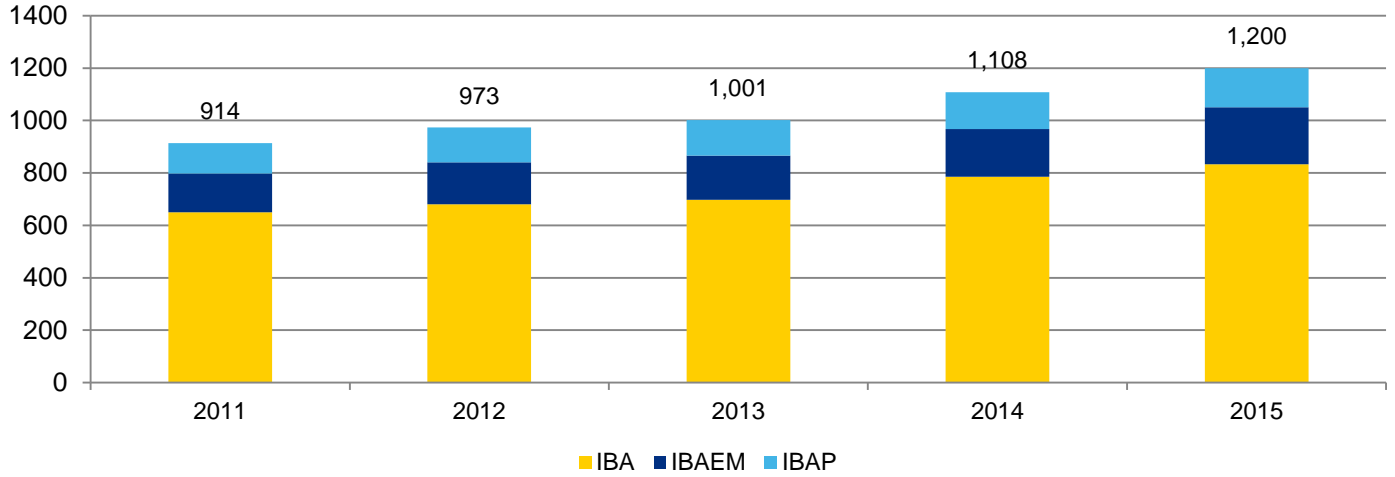


### MYP Candidates by Gender

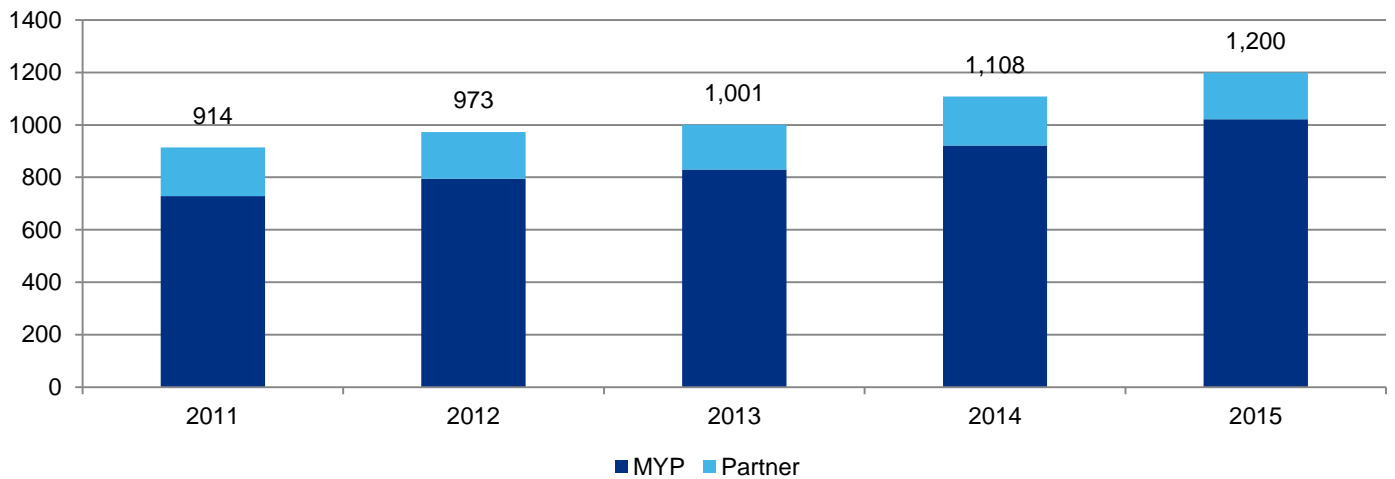

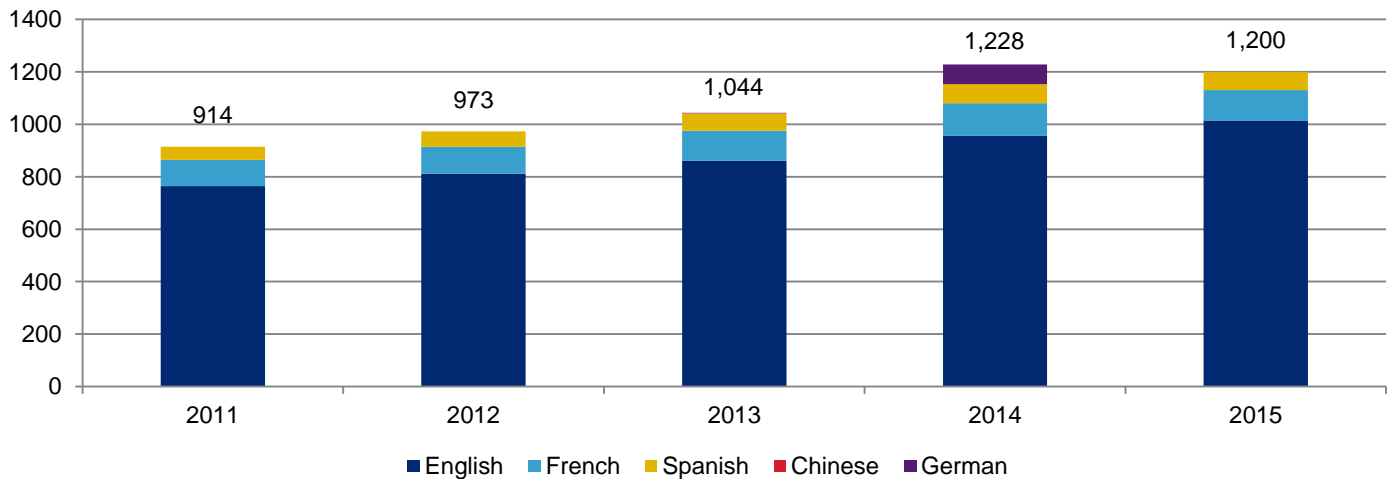
### MYP Schools by Region



### School Growth by School Type



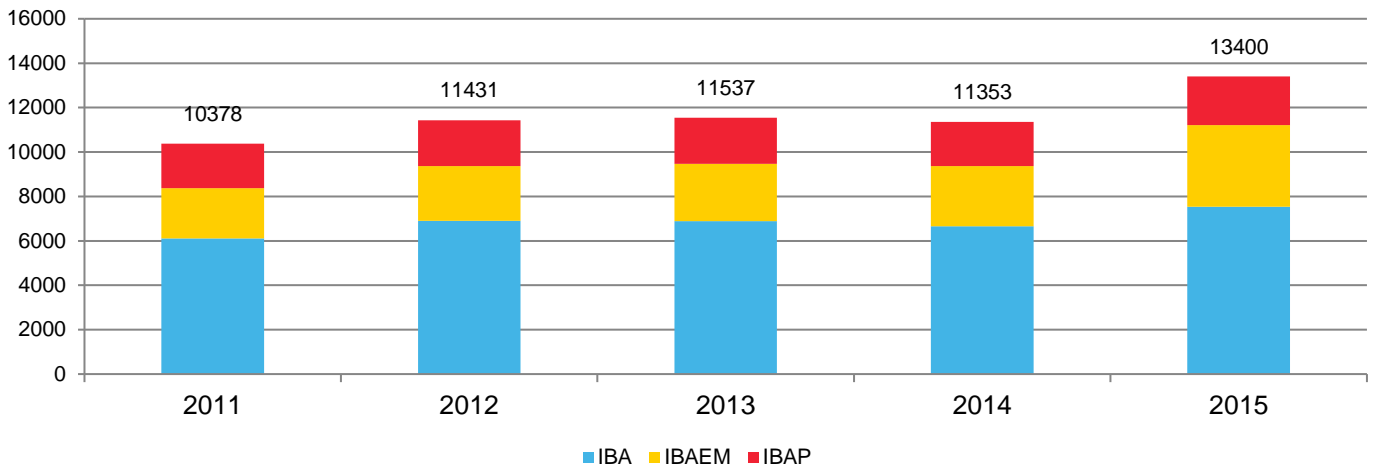

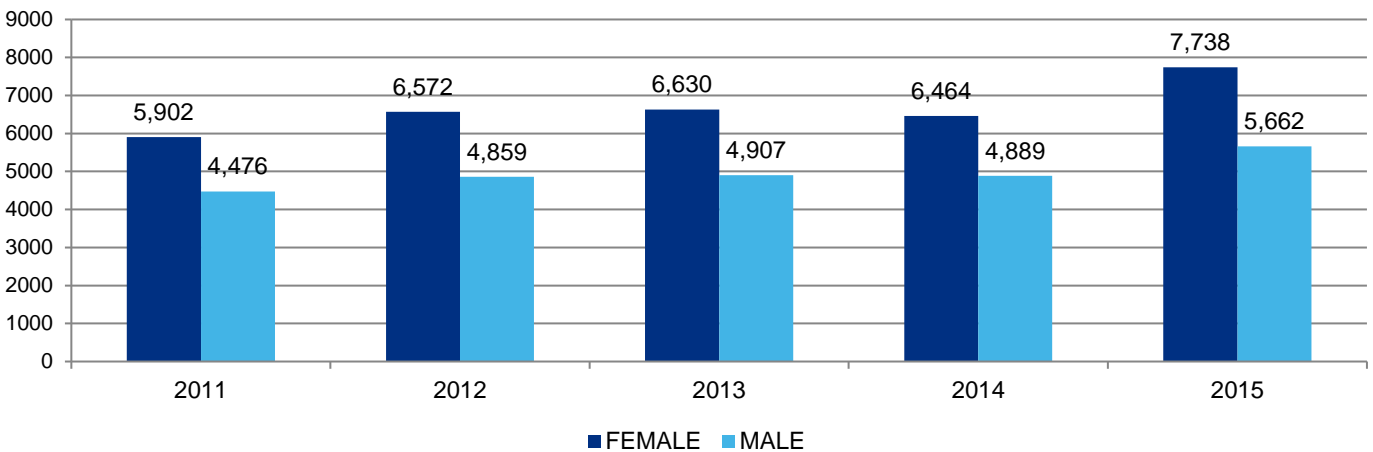

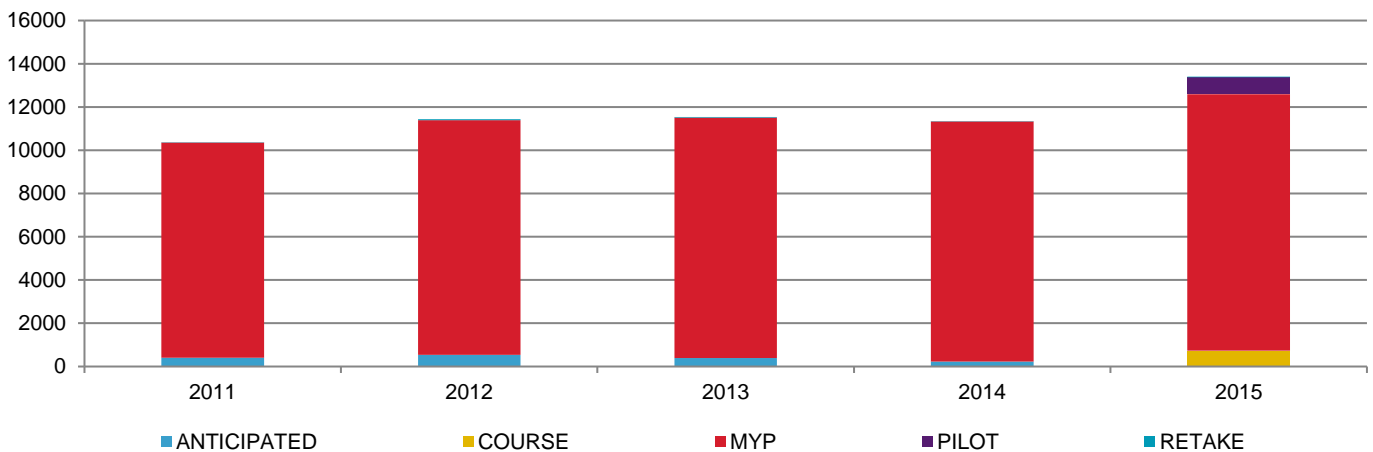
## MYP Candidates by Region

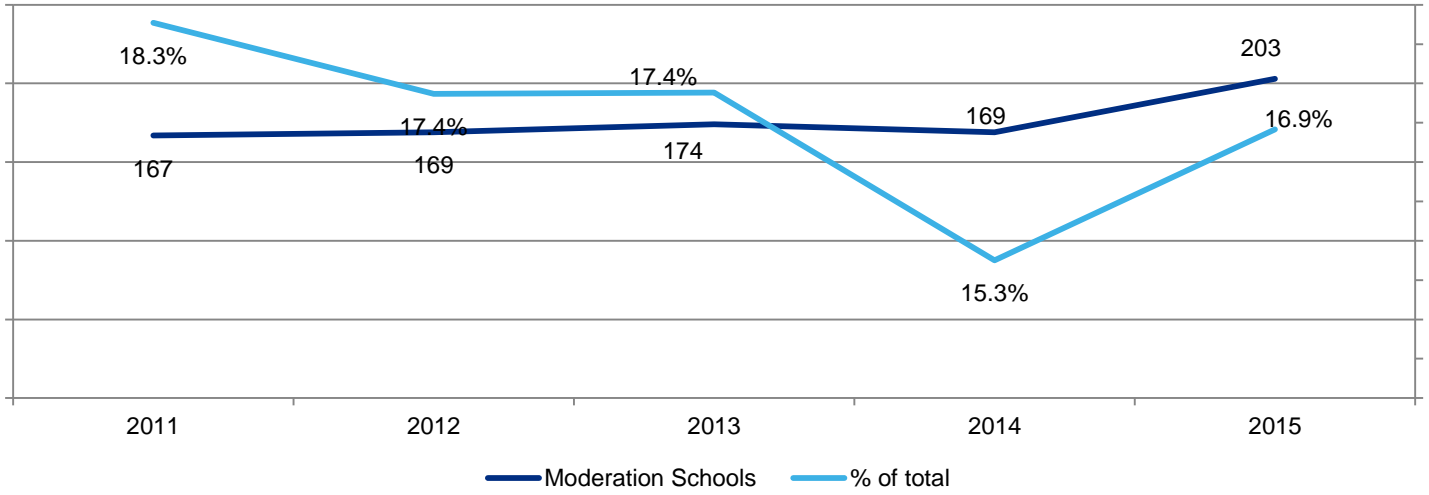

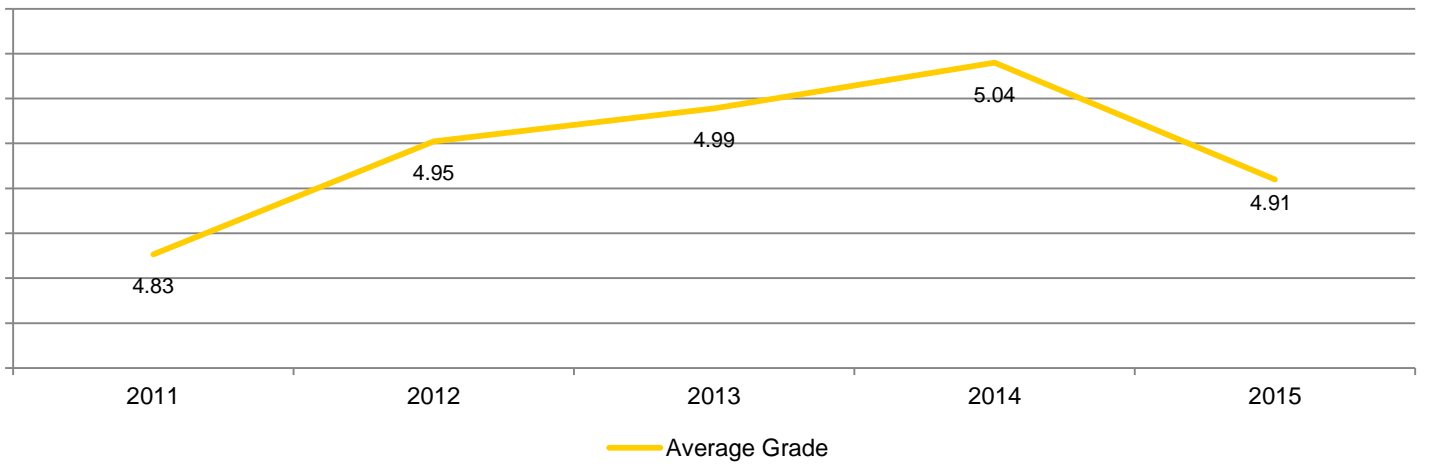

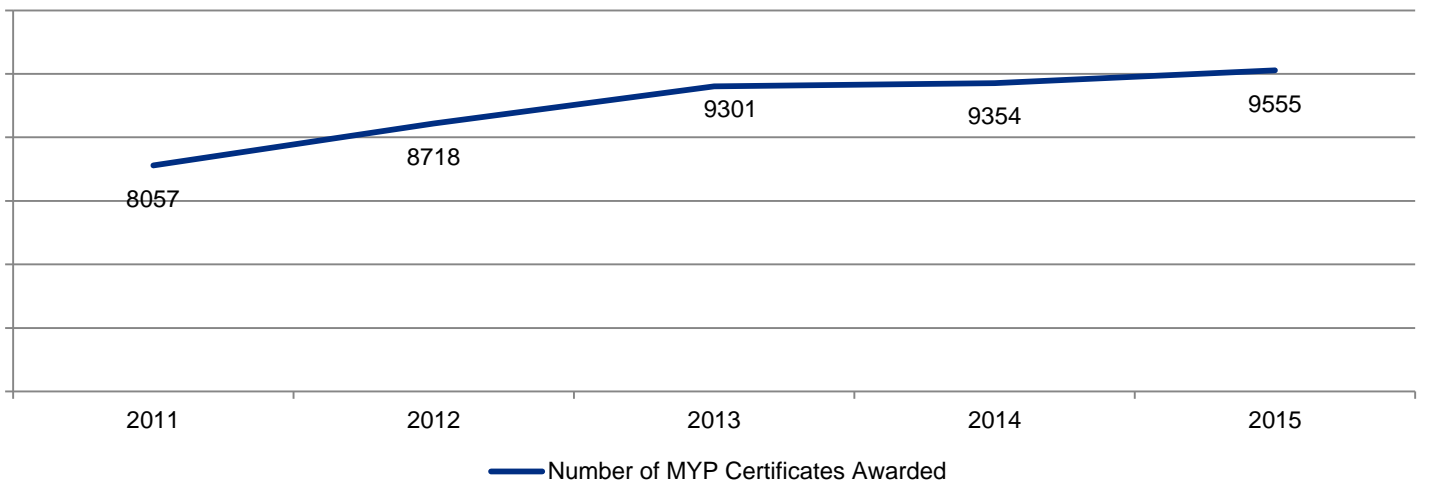
### Number and Percent of Schools with Certificate Candidates
