How to show colleges what they want: Context

- School profile -
 - When was IB instituted and why?
 - How many IB students at the school/in grade 12?
 - Proportion/number of full diploma students?
 - Historical pass rate/average score?
 - IB grade distribution last year?
 - Which classes offered at HL?
 - More than 3 HL allowed?





How to show colleges what they need: Clarity

- Transcript
 - Identify IB (including HL/SL), AP, online, honors, dual enrollment, etc.
 - State whether IB adds point value to GPA/rank
- Clearly indicate whether student will earn full IB diploma
- Use counselor letter to highlight IB
 - Especially challenging combo of courses, extra HLs
 - EE topic or language
 - CAS as it relates to character/personality
- Help educate admission officers who don't know the IB
