The Principal examiner is responsible for the development and delivery of assessments within their discipline, under the guidance of the Chief examiner. They are closely involved in developing partially completed unit plans, examiner training, marking/moderating candidates' work, agreeing and setting standards, and determining the final grades of candidates in both the May and November sessions. They will also work closely with the Chief examiner for the subject group ensuring parity across disciplines.
