The IB is a non-profit Swiss foundation. We cover our operating and development costs by charging fees for our services. Any surplus we make in providing these services is reinvested back into the organization in pursuit of our mission.

Application fees

Application fees are charged to provide services to schools during the application process.

PYP/MYP application A fee	This fee is due when the Part A application is submitted and is charged for the reading and processing of the initial application, advice and guidance on programme implementation, access to the OCC and all curriculum materials, Coordinator Notes, etc. In the event that the application is processed but not accepted by the IB, all but CHF 2700 or GBP 1186 will be refunded.	6337	2784

PYP/MYP continuation fee	The continuation fee is payable by PYP and MYP candidate schools in September or December each year until the authorization process is complete and by Diploma candidate schools who unusually take more than one year to submit an Application B. It allows schools to continue to receive programme implementation support, access to all curriculum materials, etc.	8605	3785

PYP/MYP/Diploma application B fee*	This fee is due when the Part B application is submitted and is charged for reading and processing the application, scheduling and providing the two day authorization visit, and processing the visit report and recommendation to IB headquarters.	5400	2372

School support fees

Support fees are charged when a consultant or workshop leader visits your school.

Consultation visit daily fee*	When an IB consultant visits a school (for example, a preliminary visit, information visit, return authorization visit if authorization was postponed, etc) we charge this daily fee per consultant which includes a written visit report.	914	1188	522
In-school workshop fee*	When we arrange a workshop at your school, we charge a fee per participant per day of training to cover all workshop preparation, leader training, staffing, certification, and review costs. There is a minimum of 10 participants.	105	136	60

Payment currency:

Authorized IB World Schools must pay in their assigned currency. All other schools must pay in GBP, except for schools in Switzerland who may pay in CHF.

* Expenses

In addition to the fixed fees above, schools will be responsible for the actual travelling expenses incurred by our consultants or leaders undertaking the visit/workshop as well as reasonable economy travel, hotel and other incidental living costs.
