Category 1

TARGET AUDIENCE:

The main purpose of workshops in this category is to provide professional development and assistance for schools that have decided to apply for IB authorization.

They are equally relevant for educators who are new to a school with an existing IB programme and those interested in joining an IB school.

GOALS:

Provide an introduction of the IB to educators new to the programme (subject specific workshops).

Prepare educators to successfully implement the IB programme (generic introductory workshops).

OBJECTIVES:

Participants will make connections between the programme framework and practice.

Participants will enhance their understanding of the role of assessment in IB programmes.

Participants will discuss and analyze standards and practices appropriate to their role.

Participants will engage in discussion and activities aimed at sharing pedagogical techniques such as:

Diploma Programme workshops

WHAT IS...?

A 'Generic language' workshop

A workshop designated as 'Generic' is the means by which the IB supports professional development for languages in the DP where a language specific workshop is not available. The format will typically have a common core for content and materials, supplemented by language specific materials related to the languages taught by the participants. The workshop will be presented most commonly in English.

An 'Administrators workshop' (Cat. 1 only)

Aimed at those in leadership roles in schools (heads, directors, principals, academic deans, senior leadership teams, etc), this workshop focuses on the needs of those managing schools and line-managing those involved in the coordination and delivery of the Diploma Programme. Sessions take a broad approach to the DP and cover philosophy, general content and specific administrative matters and concerns, such as budgeting, resources etc.

A 'Coordination workshop'

This workshop focuses upon the essential skills for a coordinator new to the position. It can be thought of as a toolbox for DP coordination, interlaced with practical advice and good practice.

A 'CAS coordination workshop'

The Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) programme at a school is central to the broader development of each participant. To promote and coordinate the programme requires a full understanding of the principles, the philosophy and also the practical aspects of an eventual implementation, within the context of the school. This is a workshop to equip potential CAS coordinators with the necessary tools to prime and develop a strong CAS programme. An important part is the sharing of good practice and advice born of experience.

A 'Subject specific seminar'

This is a category 3 workshop to officially address changes to the Diploma Programme curriculum in the diploma review cycle. New subject guides are published at the beginning of a given calendar year. Subject specific seminars will be offered on-line and at face-to-face events within the first 3 months of that year. Any workshops which follow the special subject seminar will work to the new subject guide; any workshops which precede the special subject seminar will work to the existing guide.

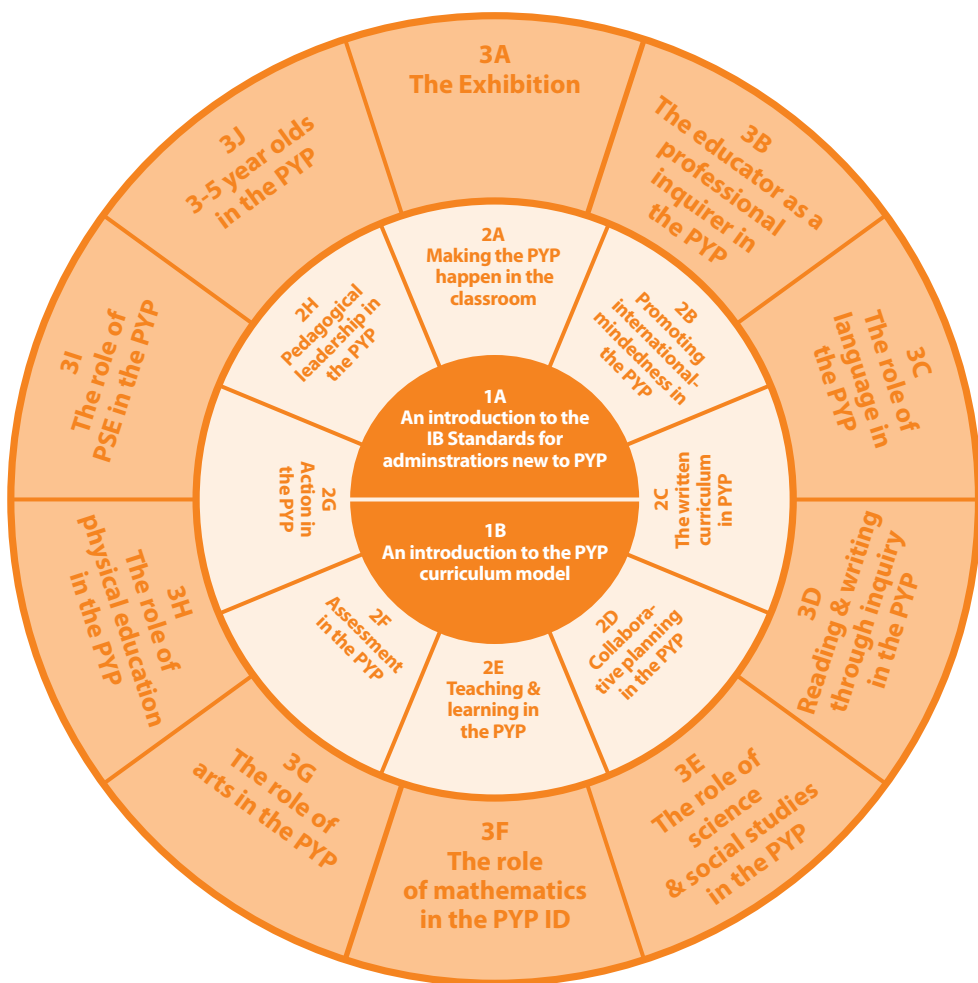

For workshops run by Professional Development Providers other than IB Africa, Europe, Middle East office, registrations are made directly with the Professional Development Providers concerned and registration is via their website (see Pages 4-5) and are subject to the conditions they apply. Cancellations/transfers are independent to IB-run workshops.

Cancellation policy

Any cancellation made 22 days or more prior to the first day of the workshop will be refunded by a credit note for the full amount of the registration fee. For cancellations made 21 days or less prior to the first day of the workshop, a penalty of 100% of the fee will apply.

In the event that the IB has to cancel a workshop, the total amount of the registration fee will be refunded or will incur a credit note.

Unconfirmed registrations will not be billed or will be refunded by a credit note if the payment has been made.

Cancellation policy will apply also in cases where a visa is refused.

Travel and visas

Participants are responsible for their own travel to and from the event. If required, a visa support letter can be downloaded from the online registration system after the participant has been confirmed.
