IB examiner information

- May 2010
 - 6,400 examiners
 - 1,150 components
 - 40,000 candidates
 - 138 countries

- Annual growth of approximately 10%

IB examiner information (cont)

- Majority of examiners are based in a few countries
 - UK
 - USA
 - Australia
- International education – increase the number of examiners in other countries

- Different roles
 - Senior examiners
 - Chief examiners/assessors
 - Examiner responsible for a language
 - School based syllabus assessors
 - Operational examiners

What is an examiner? (cont)

- Operational examiners
 - Examiner
 - Mark candidates work against a markscheme or marking notes
 - Moderator
 - Moderates a teachers marking
 - Team leader
 - Principal examiners/moderators
