<p><b>ANNUAL BASIC FEE</b> This fee is payable by authorized schools and is due 1 September of each academic year. Applicant schools authorized prior to 1 March must also pay the full fee. It includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Copies of all newly developed curriculum and teacher support guides</li> <li>• Subscription to <i>IB World</i> magazine</li> <li>• Subscription to the Online Curriculum Centre (with access for all teachers)</li> </ul>	<b>6620</b>	<p>Canadian schools authorized after 1 July 1999 must pay the annual basic fees in US currency.</p>
<p><b>PROGRAMME EVALUATION FEE</b> This fee is charged three years after authorization and every five years thereafter. It covers all costs for a 2-day visit. Visits of longer duration, based on school size, will be assessed \$500 for each additional day.</p>	<b>3500</b>	<b>3500</b>

### OTHER COSTS

In addition to the fees for the Application Parts A and B, schools will need to budget funds for the following. The costs will depend on the resources already in place and the size of the proposed program, and will therefore vary from school to school. Most of these costs are also ongoing after authorization.

- Ongoing teacher professional development at IB workshops
- Time to plan for trial implementation (before and during Candidate Phase)
- Regular collaborative planning time for teachers (including specialists)
- IB publications for teachers (see the publications catalogue on the IBO website, [www.ibo.org](http://www.ibo.org))
- Costs for the position of PYP Coordinator (at least 25% release time is recommended)
- Resources for inquiry, second language teaching and international-mindedness.
