Frequently asked questions:

Why is the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes only available in English?

The Tes platform has historically been English-only. We're working on launching the IB group in French and Spanish in the future.

Why can I only upload Diploma Programme (DP) resources in the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes?

In this initial phase, the IB Diploma Programme group is for **DP educators** only. We're working on expanding the group to include the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Career-related Programme (CP).

During this initial phase, we'll be able to find out what educators like and don't like, and we can use that feedback to make improvements.

How can educators join the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes?

IB and non-IB educators can register for **free** on Tes.com and can access the IB Diploma Programme group via tes.com/IB.

How does the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes work?

Users can search for documents, images and videos using IB terminology. When uploading a resource from within the IB Diploma Programme group, the "IB" curriculum box will be pre-checked so resources can be easily found by other users.

Does the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes replace the teacher resource exchange (TRE)? How is this different from the "upload document" function on the programme communities?

The IB Diploma Programme group on Tes is not a one-to-one replacement of the TRE—it is an additional place where **both** IB and non-IB educators can upload their best material to share, for free or for sale. Users can browse by keyword and can easily find content using IB terminology, and IB educators can share IB-level material with their non-IB peers.

The **programme communities**, available via My IB, is for IB educators only. Users can share material for **free** within groups and discussion threads. The programme communities are a great place to have discussions around specific resources.

Are there moderators in the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes?

A small group of Tes moderators will keep an eye on discussions to pick up on trends or issues—the moderators will take a **light-touch** approach.

Educators can sell resources on Tes. Does the International Baccalaureate (IB) receive any profit when teachers choose to sell resources in the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes?

No. When a teacher decides to sell a resource on Tes, that agreement is between the educator and Tes—the IB is **not** involved in the transaction and therefore does not receive any money. Users can charge money for the content they upload, but signing up to Tes is free and anyone who wants to upload new free content can do so.

Is there a copyright policy for the IB Diploma Programme group on Tes?

Users are responsible for ensuring that they have appropriate and relevant copyright permissions on all the content in the resources they upload. If they do not own the copyright outright, they must obtain consent from the copyright owners or ensure that they can rely on certain permitted uses under applicable law.
