**MYP:** A stand-alone school that implements the MYP

**Partner:** A group of schools that work together to implement the MYP across an educational continuum, where one or more offer the earlier years of the MYP, with the final years being offered by another school

## MYP Candidate Categories

**Course:** Candidates who register for subjects that cannot meet the requirements of the IB MYP Certificate

**Certificate:** Candidates who register for assessment in subjects that could lead to the IB MYP Certificate

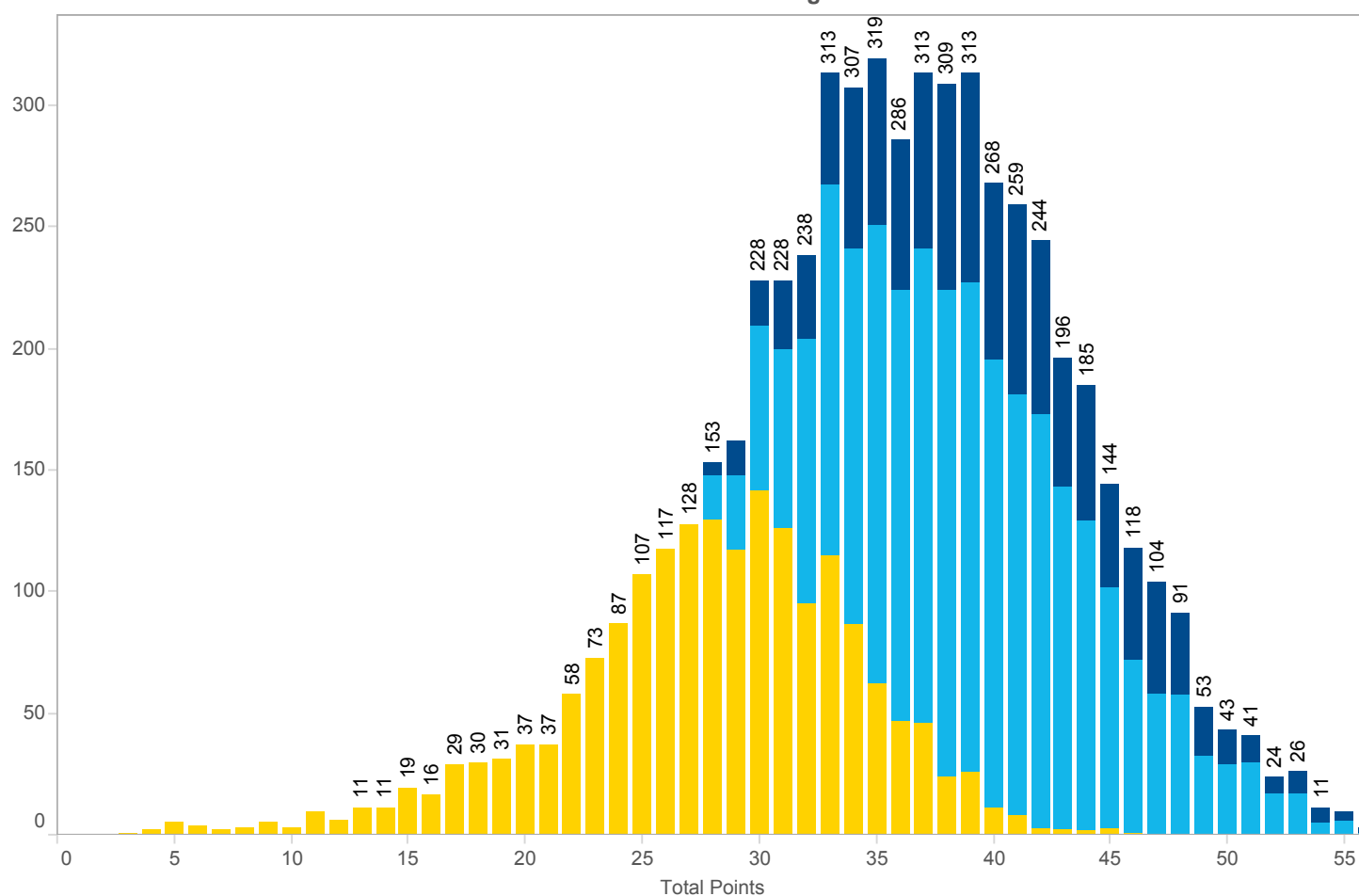

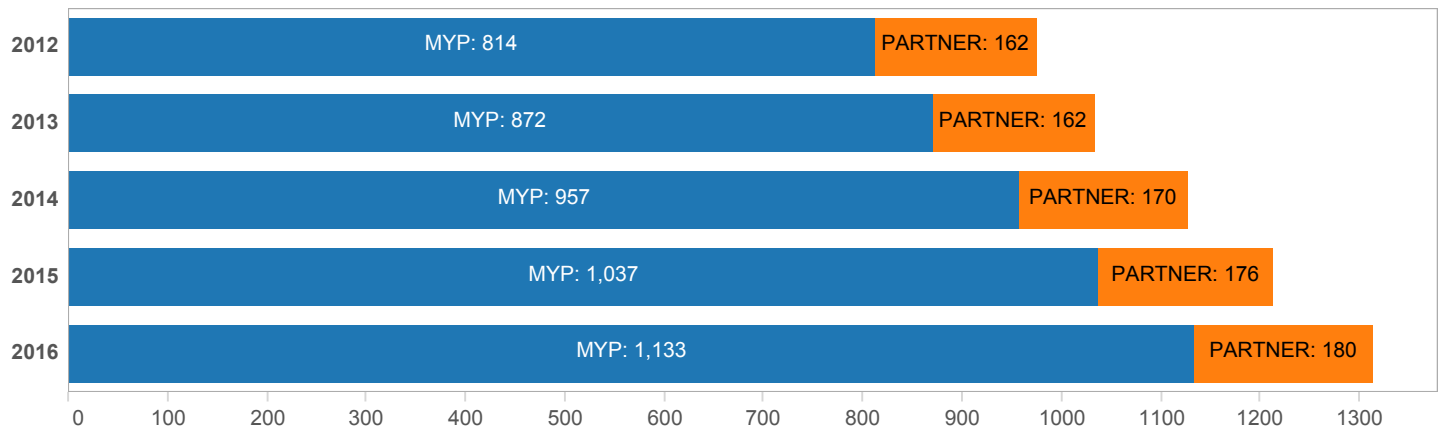

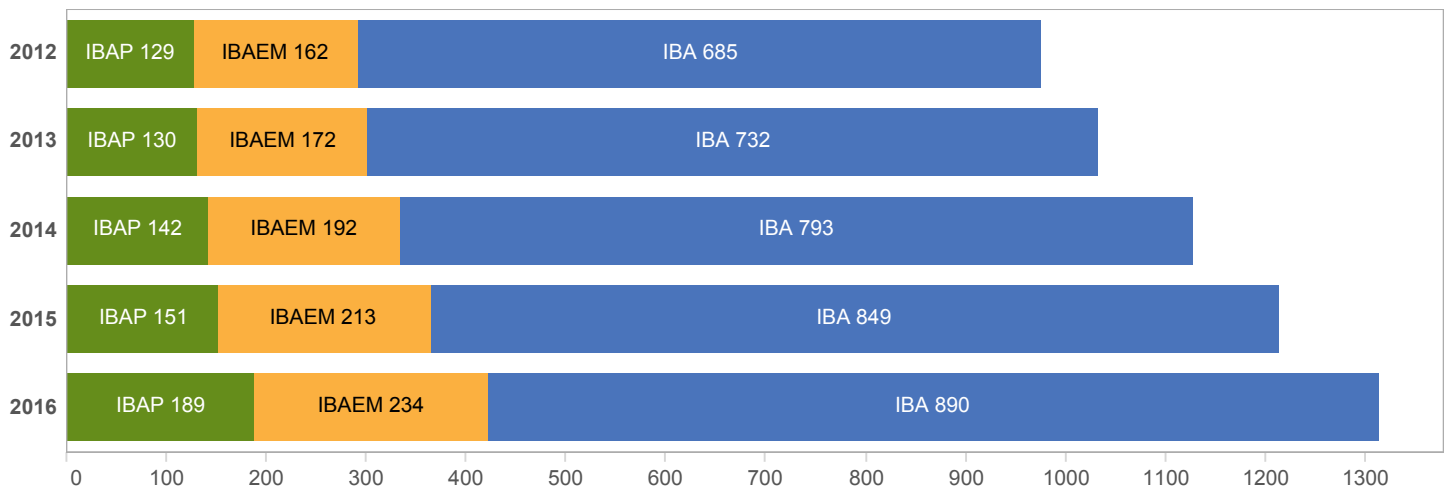

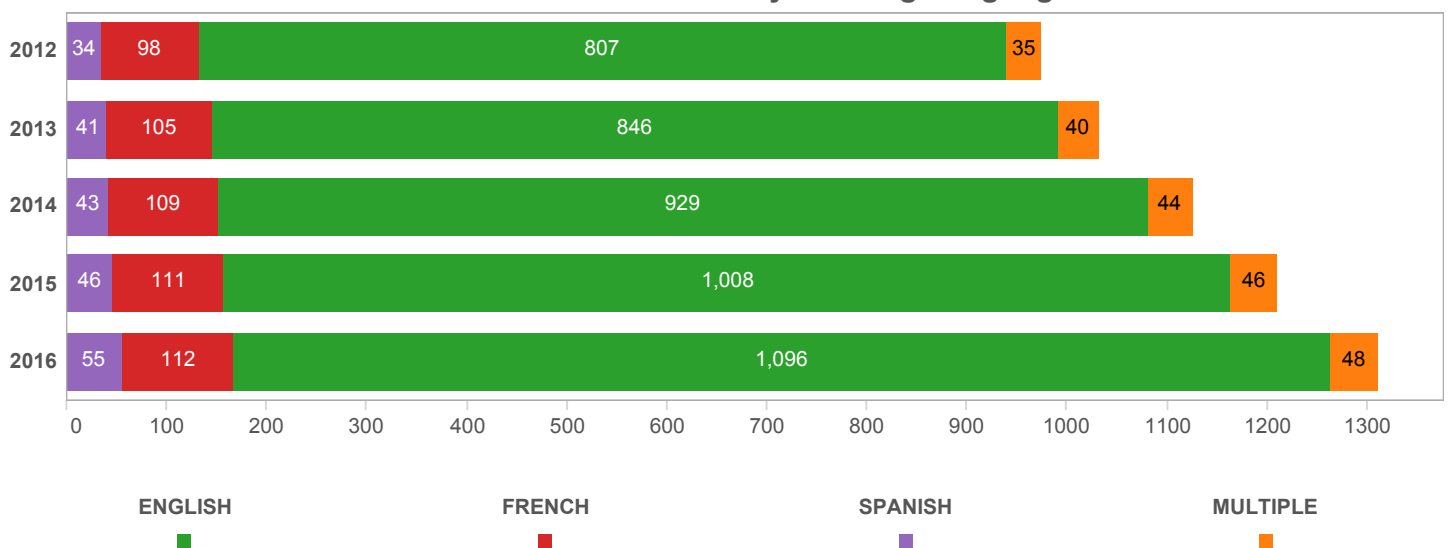
## MYP Authorized Schools by School Type

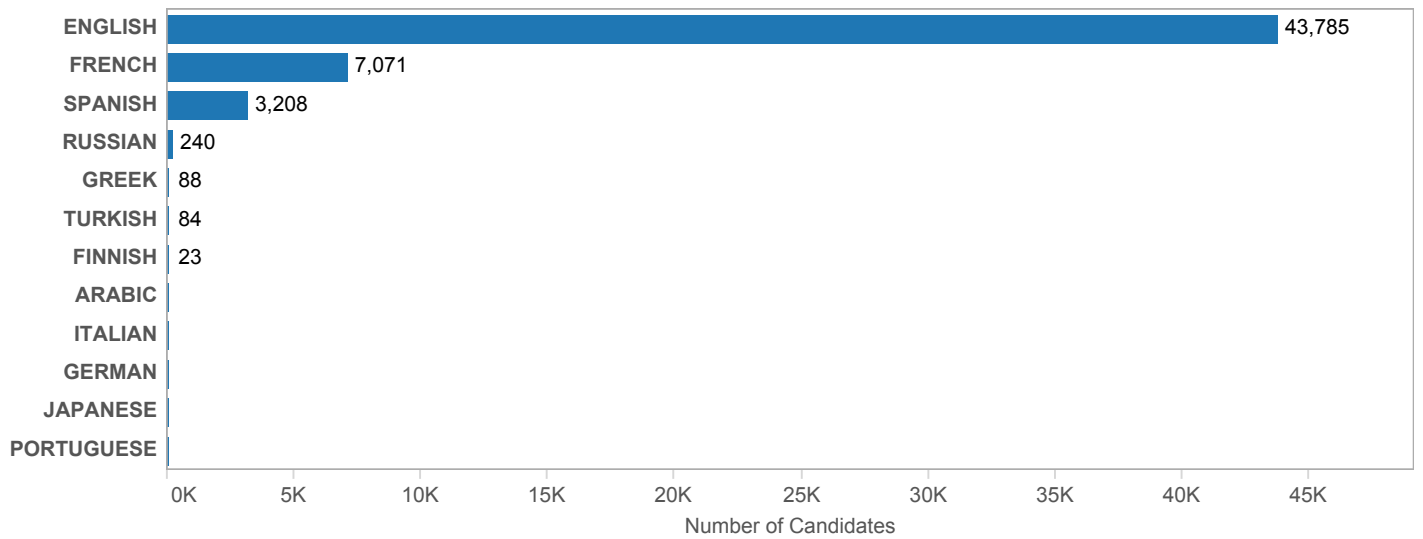

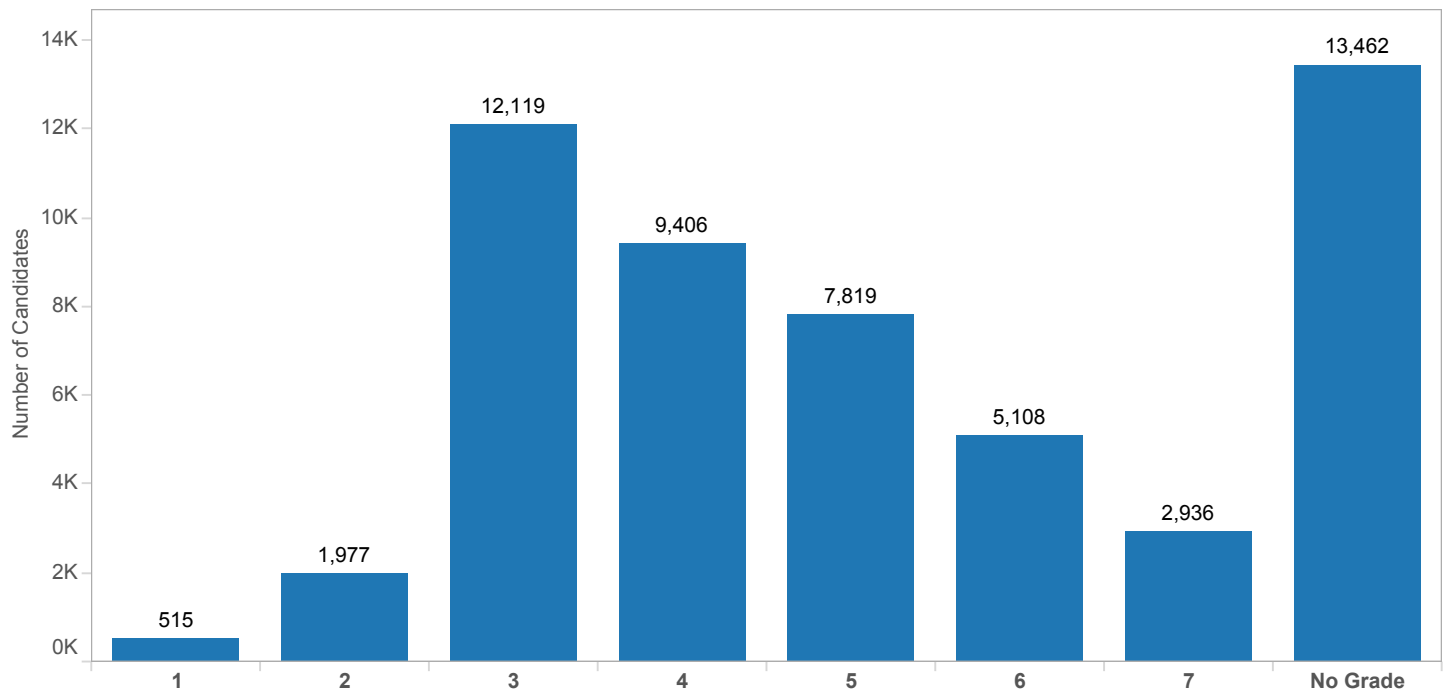
