Principal Examiner for MYP Integrated Humanities

The MYP individuals and societies subject group incorporates disciplines traditionally studied under humanities and social sciences. This subject group encourages learners to respect and understand the world around them, and equips them with the necessary skills to inquire into historical, geographical, political, social, economic, and cultural factors that affect individuals, societies and environments.

The Principal examiner is responsible for the development and delivery of assessments within their discipline, under the guidance of the Chief examiner. They are closely involved in developing partially completed unit plans, examiner training, marking/moderating candidates' work, agreeing and setting standards, and determining the final grades of candidates in both the May and November sessions. They will also work closely with the Chief examiner for the subject group ensuring parity across disciplines.

Attendance at meetings, held either face-to-face or virtually, is a requirement of this position as is the ability to be involved in the authoring process if required.

All essential and desirable skills, qualifications and experience are listed in the recruitment policy available on the IB senior recruitment pages.

The role is normally held for a period of 5 years, with an annual review.

The closing date for applications is **Friday 5 October 2018**.

Successful applicants will be notified by the end of November 2018.

Appointments will take effect from **1 December 2018**.
