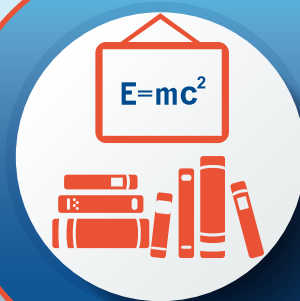

MYP eAssessment includes:

- ▶ One personal project which is a long-term, independent inquiry
- ▶ Four on-screen examinations in mathematics, sciences, language and literature, and individuals and societies
- ▶ Two ePortfolios of coursework in language acquisition, and arts/design/physical and health education
- ▶ First-in-class on screen examination focused on interdisciplinary learning
