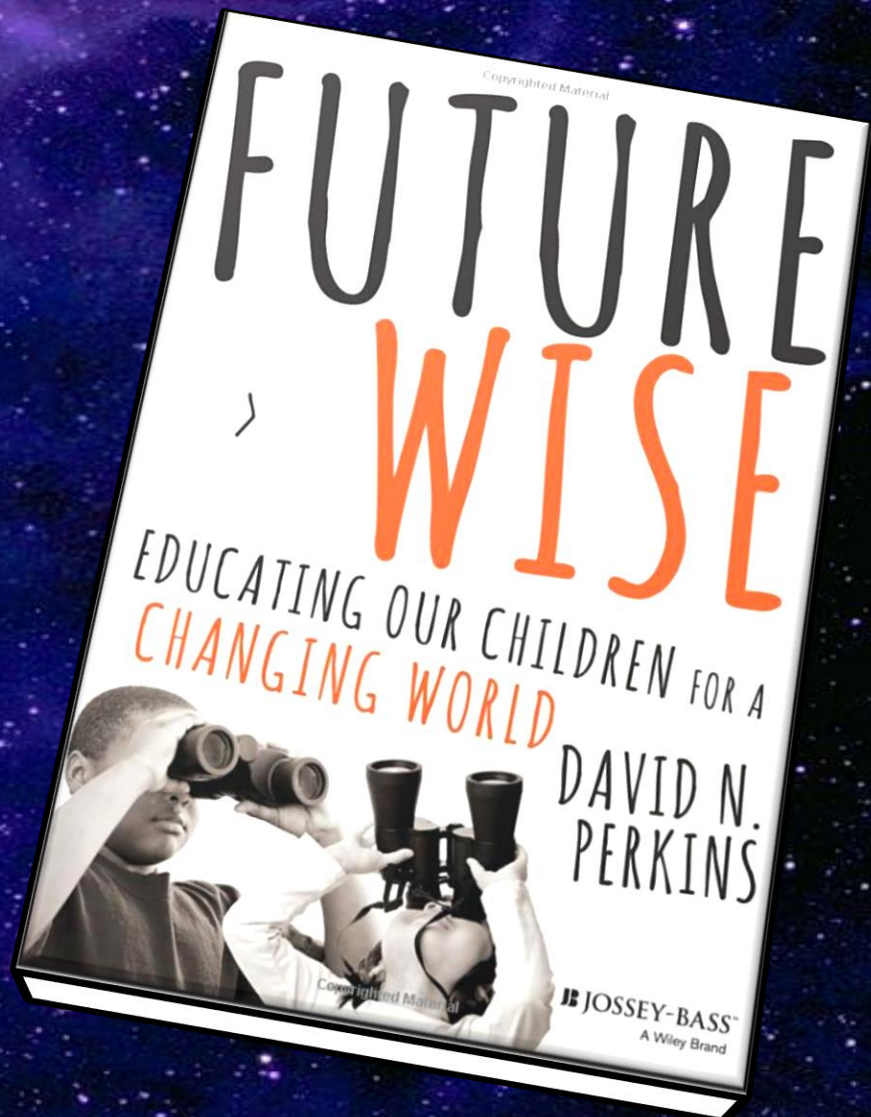

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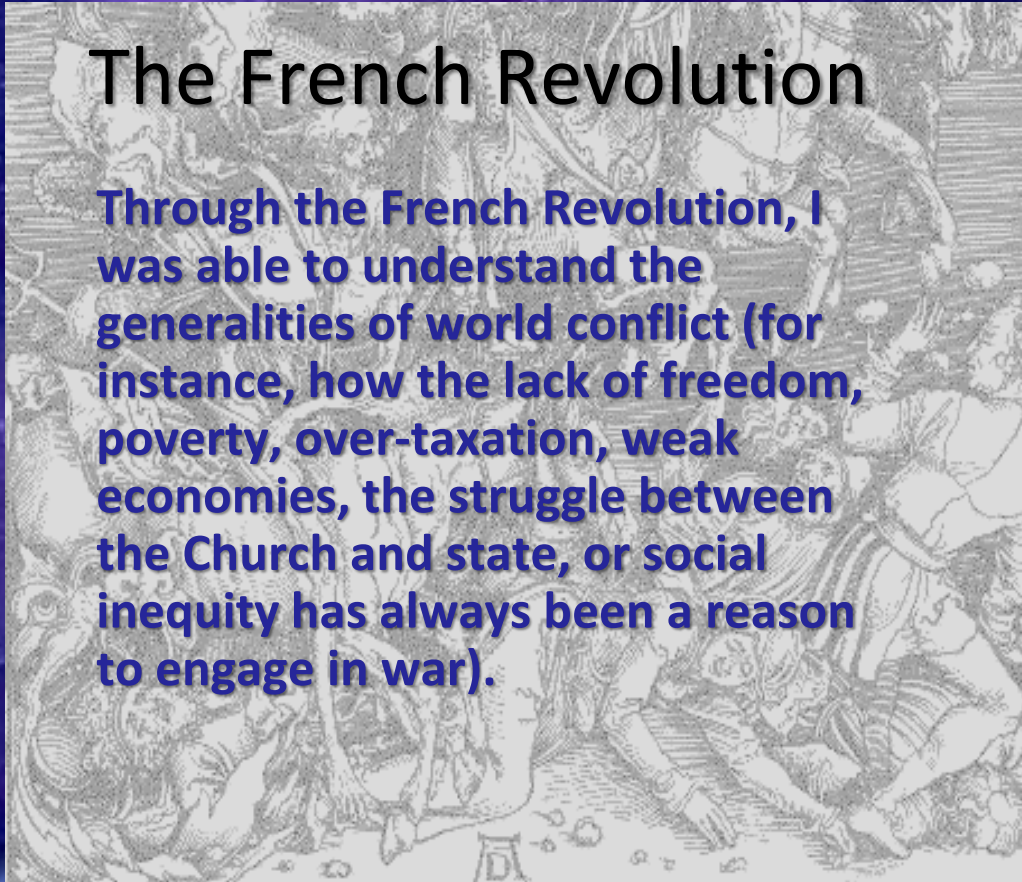

The French Revolution

Narrative



(1) narratives are helpful in thinking about our world.

(2) nuances will inevitably emerge which may challenge our narratives.

(3) if we do decide to believe in a narrative, we had better be ready, willing and able to defend it.

(4) while narratives have an unmistakable allure, it is crucial to NEVER overlook evidence that will support a contrary position just because it is easier to maintain an original one.

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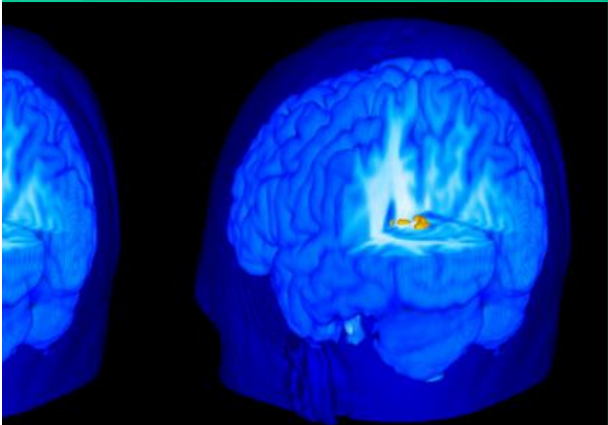
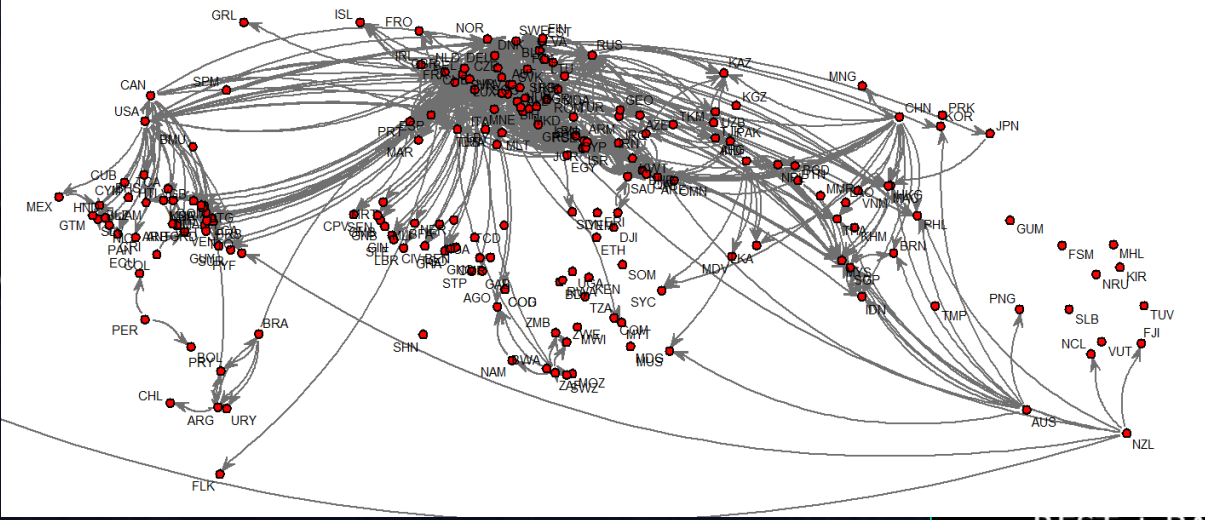

World trade in fresh potatoes, flows over 0.1 m US\$ average 2005-2009

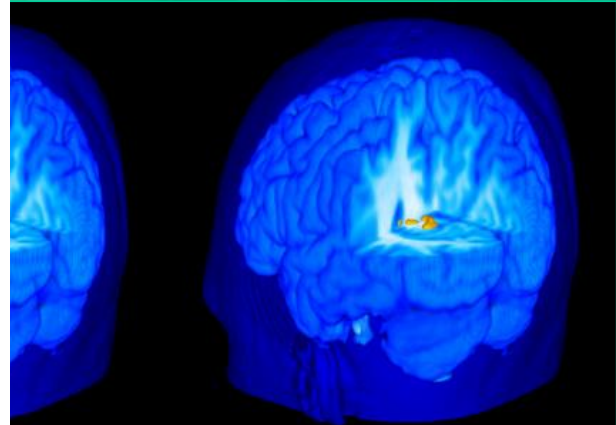
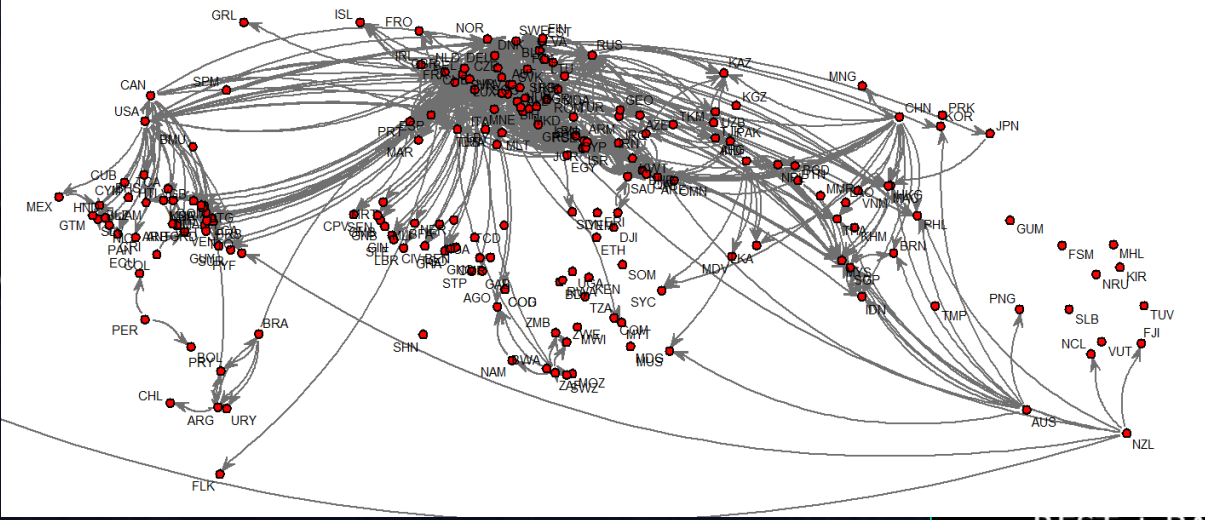
