As you pursue the **IB certificate in teaching and learning**, you will examine the principles and practices associated with one of the four IB programs—Primary Years Program (PYP), Middle Years Program (MYP), Diploma Program (DP) and Career-related Program (CP). The courses that lead to this certificate shape pre-service, new and experienced educators into reflective practitioners and teacher researchers.

IB advanced certificate in teaching and learning research

Educators who pursue the **IB advanced certificate in teaching and learning research** wish to supplement their existing IB experience with rigorous, systematic investigative work to further their knowledge and experience. You will delve deeper into curriculum development, pedagogy and assessment through the exploration of relevant literature and your own IB practices. Educators will need at least three years of documented IB teaching experience to earn this certificate.



Building on our reputation for excellence in online learning, the units focused on IB programs represent current, attractive, easily navigable and highly interactive online learning experiences supported by dedicated academic staff. Students admitted to the Bachelor of Education degree with Curtin University who choose to complete the full suite of four IB units as part of their program will graduate with the IB certificate in teaching and learning as well as the bachelor's degree. In addition, graduates who complete the IB units as part of their Bachelor of Education program will satisfy the requirements for a primary education specialization.

Study in three of the units is open to all students to enrol through Open Universities Australia, including students enroled in Curtin degree programs. Please note that while you may enrol in individual units via Open Universities Australia, you will only be eligible to register for the certificate in teaching and learning if you complete the units as part of the Bachelor of Education.

REQUIRED COURSES

To qualify for the IB certificate in teaching and learning, students must successfully complete the four units listed below as part of the Bachelor of Education.

- 1. Introduction to the International Baccalaureate (25 credit points)
- 2. Either: IB Primary Years Program OR IB Middle Years Program (25 credit points)
- 3. The International Baccalaureate in Action (25 credit points)
- 4. Final Professional Experience (The Internship) (100 credit points)— In a recognized IB World School (full time placement as per standard requirements for the Internship unit)

MODE OF DELIVERY Online

MINIMUM TIME TO COMPLETE PROGRAM The Bachelor of Education is a four-year full-time program (or equivalent). Each IB unit takes 13 weeks to complete.

PRIOR IB EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS None

Please note that students are not required to complete all four units, but the IB certificate in teaching and learning can only be awarded if all four are successfully completed as part of the Bachelor of Education. Note that units 3 and 4 cannot be undertaken unless units 1 and 2 have been successfully completed or credited from another institution.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Enrolment into the following courses is open to all via Open Universities Australia:

- Introduction to the International Baccalaureate,
- IB Primary Years Program
- IB Middle Years Program.

Taking these units individually does not make one eligible for the IB certificate in teaching and learning.

HOW TO APPLY

Enrolment in each unit is undertaken through the Open Universities Australia website.

Students not already admitted to the BEd who are interested in pursuing the BEd and gaining the IB certificate in teaching and learning will need to enrol via the Open Universities Australia website and meet all eligibility criteria before applying to the Bachelor of Education with Curtin University.

Students can apply for a pathway within this program that prepares them for teaching in IB PYP schools and to gain the IB certificate in teaching and learning (PYP). The pathway involves taking two elective units, including an elective focusing specifically on the IB PYP, and taking two third year professional placements in IB PYP schools.

The focus on the early years in the IB PYP is a highlight of this program of study. Whilst graduates will gain the skills and knowledge to work in an IB PYP setting, the program has a strong focus on the early years (3–8), providing specialist understanding of teaching in this context.

REQUIRED COURSES

To qualify for the certificate, the following courses and placement are required as part of the 32-credit point program of study:

- EEG402 Teaching in a Global World (1 credit)

The remaining two units focus on play and inquiry, as well as assessing and evaluating learning in global early years contexts.

In addition, they gain the IB certificate in teaching and learning (PYP). The course involves students taking four core units, including a unit focusing specifically on the IB PYP, and one that involves fieldwork in IB PYP programs. The remaining two units focus on play and inquiry and on assessing and evaluating learning in global early years contexts.

The focus on the early years in the IB PYP is a highlight of this program of study. Whilst graduates will gain the skills and knowledge to work in an IB PYP setting, the program has a strong focus on the early years (3–8), providing specialist understanding of teaching in this context.
